Overview of Conference!

Pre-Conference Event: an evening to allow delegations to meet each other in a relaxed atmosphere to network. The focus will be on team-building and communication skills.

Day 1 – Heart to Heart

Student delegates will meet their MO Ambassadors who will guide them to their caucus rooms for introductions and schedules. A “VISION STATEment” Ceremony will open the conference introducing all delegations. The focus of the day will inspire leaders to share the value of their council programs through small/large group workshops called “heartbeats”.

Day 2 – Pulse of Leadership

The goal for this day is to lead the students through challenging “chambers” of leadership training. Delegates will be divided into small groups to participate in skill building, team-building and officer training. A service project with special Olympics Missouri will be included.

Day 3 – And the Beat Goes On

An opportunity to “Swag Swap” and trade items from home councils allows delegates to share their hearts, shirts, and state pins with each other. Students will be motivated to return to their homes ready to keep their passion alive. The goal for the day is sending participants home with a challenge to use their newly learned skills.
